Derry City Council in conjunction with Drumahoe Community Association have arranged a street by street clean-up of

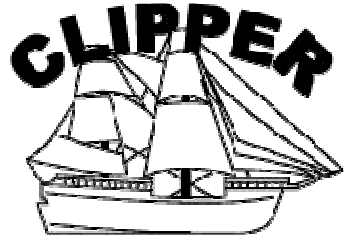
Drumahoe on **23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> May 2011.**
