WINTER FUEL PAYMENT

Most people do not need to make a claim for Winter Fuel Payment because the Department for Work and Pensions should pay it automatically. Most of those aged 60-79 will get £200 instead of last year's £250. Those who are 80 or older will get £300 instead of £400 last year. (Amounts are per household). Payments will be made in November or December. If you have not received an automatic payment by the end of December, you should contact Citizens Advice Bureau Tel: 71362444 or 369401

COLD WEATHER PAYMENTS

Social fund payments are available (paid automatically) for periods which are designated as periods of cold weather. Each postcode area of the country is linked to a weather station. This sends information on the temperature it forecasts/records for its own area to the Department for Work and Pensions. The weather station must either forecast or record an average daily temperature over seven consecutive days averaging 0°C or below. Payments are £25.00. Only people on certain Welfare Benefits will qualify.
