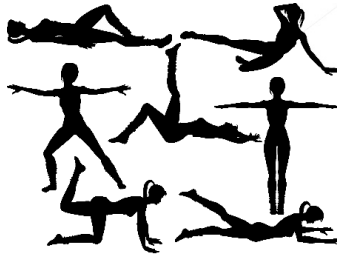

Dog Fouling

Unfortunately after numerous requests from the DCA to ask dog owners to be responsible citizens and clean up after their dog, a number of owners continue to allow their dogs to foul on our streets.

The Community Association have consulted the city dog wardens who have agreed to increase their presence in the Drumahoe area and as a way of identifying irresponsible dog owners the DCA are looking for residents to email us at info@drumahoe.org or contact any committee member with details of persistent offenders. The dog warden will then contact the individuals involved directly.

Faughan Valley School site

The outline planning application has now been passed for the former Faughan Valley School site. This has allowed Derry City Council and the DCA to progress with the next stage of the community strip which will include producing more detailed plans of our proposed development prior to a public consultation where the residents views will be heard.

Meals-on-Wheels
