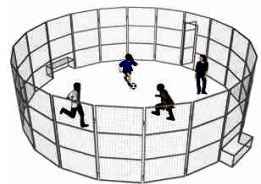

The Dog Warden will then contact the individuals involved directly.

Playpark update

After the excitement of being awarded the funding for the District Park there is much work now being undertaken to ensure we comply with the strict conditions set out by the Funders. Currently we hope to have consultants appointed by the end of September 2016 with the Tender process being undertaken during the first quarter of 2017. This will hopefully mean contractors should be on site during June 2017. All dates are obviously subject to change but you can be assured that stakeholders will do everything to ensure prompt completion.

With the District park ongoing we are hoping to progress other projects within the Drumahoe area and to that end we are required to carry out a Community Audit. The audit will help us develop a strategy based on the needs and aspirations of the residents of Drumahoe and surrounding area.
